
#### <u>Tuesday – December 2nd, 2025- Mobile, Alabama (1) Night</u>

- Oak Alley Plantation: From its beginnings over 200 years ago, Oak Alley is a National Historic Landmark, dedicated to preserving and interpreting the history its inhabitants left behind. With an emphasis on its time as a sugar plantation, visitors are invited to walk under its iconic alley, explore its exhibits: Slavery at Oak Alley, the 'Big House', Sugarcane Theater, People of Oak Alley and the Blacksmith Shop and leave with a better understanding of this plantation's complex

- National Museum of Funeral History Houston: This museum, owned by a funeral company, houses the largest collection of funereal artifacts in the U.S., traces the history of funeral services, displays historic hearses and provides memorabilia from funerals of the famous, such as Dwight Eisenhower, Martin Luther King Jr., John F. Kennedy and Elvis Presley.

- San Antonio River Walk Boat Tour
- **The ALAMO:** The Alamo is a historical site with a special place in the heart of many Texans. In 1836, The Alamo was the site of a 13-day siege during the Texas Revolution. Known today as the Battle of the Alamo, the brave stand put up by the Texian soldiers who defended the then-fortress went down in history.
- **Japanese Tea Gardens:** Tucked inside of historic Brackenridge Park, lies the San Antonio Japanese Tea Garden, a limestone quarry, turned tranquil, multi-level, Asian-inspired garden and pond in the early 1900's.
- **Gunther House with Lunch:** is a restaurant, museum and store located at 205 E. Guenther Street in the King William neighborhood. Currently operated by C. H. Guenther and Son. Inc., the home was originally built as a private residence in 1859 by Pioneer Flour Mills founder Carl Hilmar Guenther, now on the National Register of Historic Places



#### Saturday December 6th, 2025-San Antonio, TX

- **Briscoe Western Art Museum:** The Briscoe Western Art Museum, located on the banks of the historic San Antonio River Walk, brings to life the vibrant culture and heritage of the Western United States. The Museum offers a permanent collection of Western art and artifacts, providing visitors from San Antonio and beyond the opportunity to experience artifacts and artwork depicting the American cowboy, American Indian, the Vaquero and the many diverse cultures that forged the American West.

- **Lyndon B. Johnson National Historical Park:** President Johnson had a deep attachment for place and heritage. The LBJ Ranch was where he was born, lived, died, and was buried. After the president's death in 1973, Mrs. Johnson continued to live at the Ranch part time until her death in 2007.



#### <u>Sunday December 7<sup>th</sup></u>, 2025 – San Antonio, TX

- San Antonio Missions UNESCO World Heritage Site:
- **King William Historic District:** Settled by wealthy German merchants in the late 1800s, San Antonio's first suburb consists of 25 blocks of historic mansions set amid lovely landscaping.
- The Buckhorn Saloon and Texas Ranger Museums: The Buckhorn Saloon is where it all began-where history was made and legend lives. It is where Teddy Roosevelt recruited Rough Riders and Pancho Villa is rumored to have planned the Mexican Revolution. Many of the original furnishings still grace today's Buckhorn Saloon, including the back-bar which was hand-crafted of marble and cherry wood. The bar features locally brewed beers on draft. You might also like one of our delicious and icy Prickly Pear Margaritas; it's a Texas favorite!
